On behalf of the International Society for Seed Science (ISSS), we are pleased to send out this final announcement for the “5th Workshop on the Molecular Aspects of Seed Dormancy and Germination” that will be held at Simon Fraser University (Harbour Centre), Vancouver, Canada. Advancements in the scientific understanding of seed biology will be highlighted within the context of seed dormancy and germination, and biological processes that control the viability and vigor of the next generation. Frontier research on the characterization of Delay of Germination proteins (DOG1 and DOG6) will be disclosed for the first time as well as emerging mechanisms of epigenetics in seeds, which have great potential for future applications. Education and outreach – for youth and the public – comprise the final session.

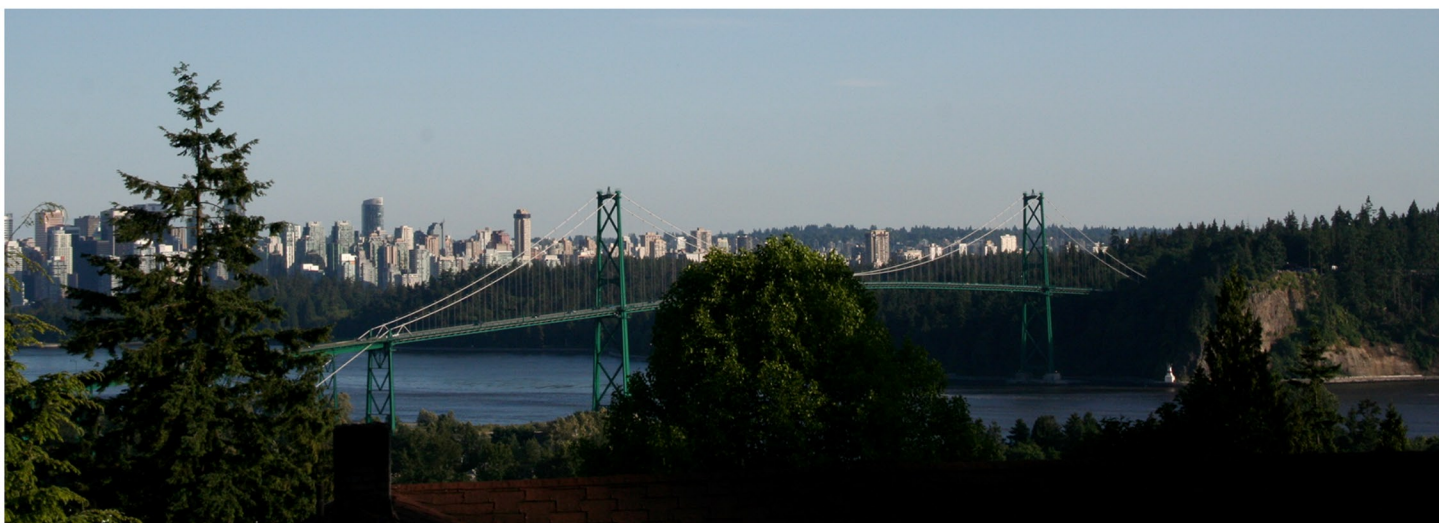
